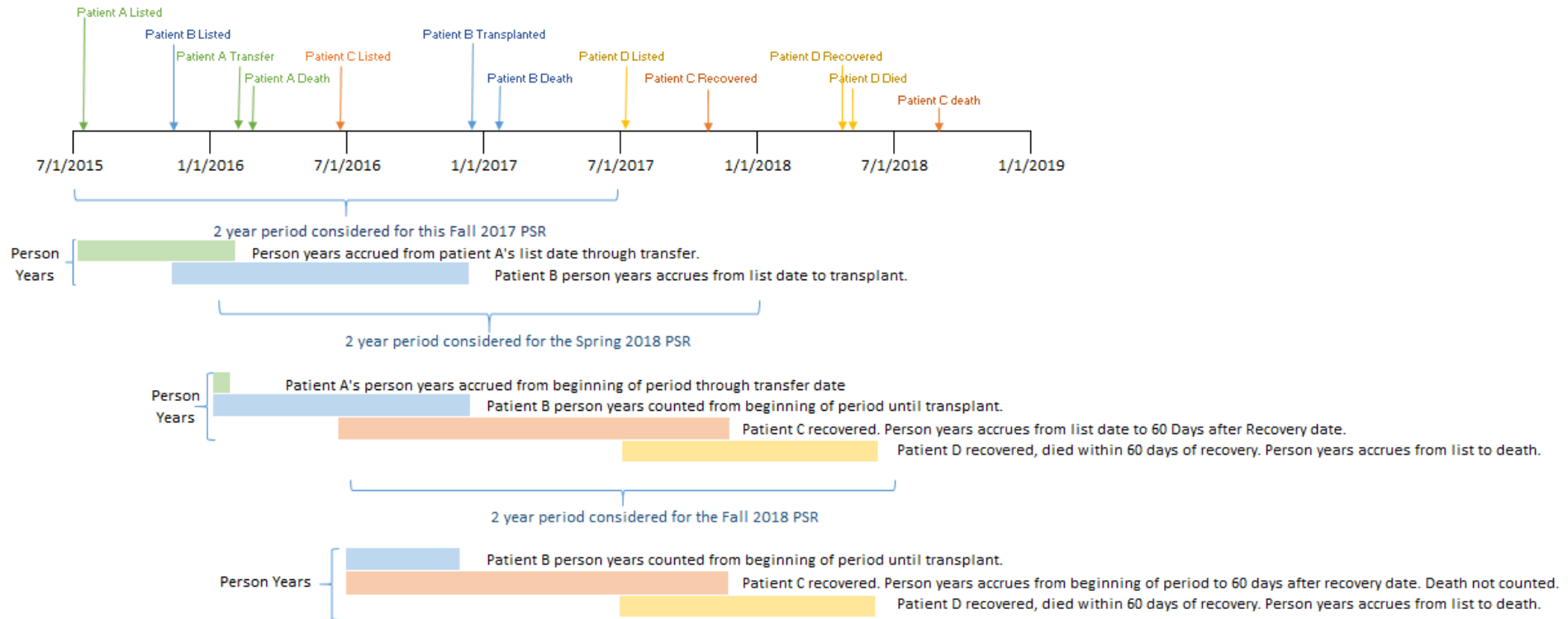


Waitlist Mortality- Patients Removed for Transplant, Recovery or Transferred.

NOTES:
 For a reporting cycle in the PSR, we look at 2 year periods.
 We put out PSRs every 6 months, so those periods roll forward 6 months.
 If patient was removed for recovery, patient followed for 60 days post removal. Person years accrue until end of 60 days. A death **would** count if it occurred between recovery and 60 days post-recovery.
 If patient was removed for transplant, or transfer, patient time ends on transplant/transfer date. Death after transplant/transfer is not counted.



Patient A was listed at center 1 and transferred to center 2. Patient A died within 60 days at center 2. Death does not count towards Center 1's mortality rate. It occurred after transfer and 60 days doesn't matter for transfers.
 Patient B was listed and received transplant. Died 90 days after transplant. That death does not count towards waitlist mortality. Once a transplant occurs, events are then counted in the posttransplant data.
 Patient C was listed, recovered and died 9 months after recovery. Death not counted because occurred after the 60 day followup.
 Patient D was listed, recovered but died in a car accident within 60 days of recovery. Death is counted because it was within 60 days and SRTR does not consider the reason for death, only that a death occurred.
